### Pastor's Peace

A collision of colossal proportions! That's what I see about to happen in February – no not the Eagles vs. the Patriots in the Super Bowl, though I am excited about that. Rather, the fact that Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday fall on the same day this year. How does that work? Can we buy chocolates, deliver roses, and write mushy poems with ash on our heads? Can we be repentant, reflect on the journey to the cross, understand our sinfulness and still have energy enough to sit through a candlelight dinner with the one we love? The ash of repentant reflection and the hearts shaped gifts of devoted love may seem to be at odds, but in actuality they we can't have one without the other.

On February 14<sup>th</sup> we'll move into the season of Lent, a season of focus on the greatest act of love ever shown. We'll be reminded that, as the ancient prophet said,

"... the fact is, it was *our* pains he carried— *our* disfigurements, all the things wrong with *us*. We thought he brought it on himself, that God was punishing him for his own failures. But it was our sins that did that to him, that ripped and tore and crushed him—*our sins!* He took the punishment, and that made us whole. Through his bruises we get healed. We're all like sheep who've wandered off and gotten lost. We've all done our own thing, gone our own way. And God has piled all our sins, everything we've done wrong, on him, on him... The plan was that he give himself as an offering for sin so that he'd see life come from it—life, life, and more life. And God's plan will deeply prosper through him. Out of that terrible travail of soul, he'll see that it's worth it and be glad he did it. Through what he experienced, my righteous one, my servant, will make many "righteous ones." (Isaiah 53:4-12, *the Message*)

It's a love not of chocolates but of sacrifice; not of perfumes but of pain; a love not only of words but of action. It's a love that puts you ahead of him; a love that sees your mess and desires you anyway. It's a love that sees your God given potential and is dying to help you to see it too.

In many ways, there is no greater pairing than that of Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day. The pairing of repentance and love; of preparation and completion; the pairing of sacrifice and joy! Yes, these are the two sides of our journey – the one which reminds us we don't have enough within ourselves to make it on our own – and the other which reminds us that "God's grace is ENOUGH. It's all we need."

2018 is off with a bang, and as Jesus said, "You haven't seen anything yet!" (John 1:50, *the Message*) I'm so thankful for all that God is up to in and through you, the people called "Mount Pisgah."

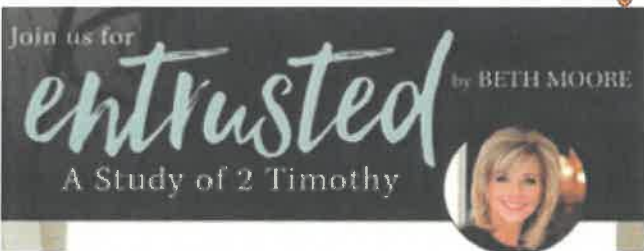
